


VFD Guide to Combination Medications

As of January 1, 2017, feed containing unapproved combinations of CTC medication and ionophores (Rumensin) cannot be fed to your animals. For example, If a CTC product is needed, Rumensin feed will need to be discontinued for the course of treatment. It may, again, be added into the diet when treatment is completed.

These combinations distinguish Aureomycin as one the most versatile chlortetracycline (CTC) products available.
